Introduction

VAMOS_ VAlorising Migrants' experience to increase their Occupational Skills (2019-1-ES01-KA202-065450) is a 3-years project funded by the Erasmus+ program (KA2 – Strategic Partnerships) and its Consortium is composed of 8 partners from Spain, Italy, Greece, and the UK that have vast experience in EUfunded projects and are active actors working with migrant population and social inclusion.

The project aims to address the need, existing in all EU countries, to enhance the experiences of migrants to allow them to act as recognized professionals in the work and social inclusion of other migrants. Therefore, the project intends to promote:

- the labor integration of migrants who are already present in the territory social
- the labor integration of newcomers

Thanks to the VAMOS project, migrants and refugees will acquire specific competences such as intercultural mediation, career guidance, communicative skills, psychological support, basics on migration legislation, identification of arriving migrants.

Throughout the project lifecycle, the main project outcomes and final results have been:

- 1. Professional Profile of the Expert in Migrants' Labor and Social Inclusion, developed by identifying key competences and essential skills required for migrants' social and labor inclusion

- 4. **Guidelines for Newcomers from Migration Experiences**, which concerns procedures to guide, accommodate, support, and integrate newcomer migrants
